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Removal of Student During School Hours

The Board of Directors recognizes its responsibility for the proper care of students during school hours. Students shall not be removed from Charter School grounds, any Charter School building, or Charter School function during school hours except by a person duly authorized in accordance with Charter School procedures. Before a student is removed or excused, the person seeking to remove the student must present, to the satisfaction of the Executive Director and/or Principal, evidence of his or her proper authority to remove the student. A teacher should not excuse a student from class to confer with anyone unless the request is approved by the Executive Director and/or Principal. The Executive Director and/or Principal is directed to establish procedures for the removal of a student during school hours.
