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THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

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Membership

The Charter School is governed by a Board of Directors consisting of not less than 3 or more than 15 members. The Board's powers and duties include the duty of directing the financial means by which the educational program is conducted. The function of the Board can be described as fiscal management, policy making, advising, and evaluating. Except as otherwise provided by law, Directors shall hold office for terms of 3 years until the date of the annual meeting of the year in which Director's term expires.

All Directors shall participate on an equal basis with other members in all business transactions. Official action by Board members must occur at a duly called and legally conducted meeting. A meeting of the Board means convening to make a decision or to deliberate toward a decision on any matter.

School board members, as individuals, have no authority over school affairs or personnel, except as provided by law or as authorized by the Board.
