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INSTRUCTION 2320

Health Enhancement Education

Health, family life, and sex education; including information about parts of the body, reproduction, and related topics; shall be included in the instructional program as appropriate to the grade level and course of study. The instructional approach shall be developed in accordance with Idaho Code 33-1608. Parents may ask to review the materials to be used and may request that their child be excluded from sex education class sessions without prejudice.

Instruction shall be developmentally appropriate to the grade level of the students and shall occur in a systematic manner. The Board particularly desires that students receive proper education about sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) before they reach the age when they may adopt behaviors that put them at risk of contracting the diseases.

Alcohol, Tobacco, and Drug Education

Students shall receive education regarding the use of alcohol, tobacco, and drugs. The Executive Director or designee shall develop curriculum for use in health education that provides instruction to students in the areas of prevention; education; treatment; rehabilitation; and legal consequences of alcohol, tobacco, and drug use.
